

**SCOPE OF WORK
FOR
GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES**

COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) has a need for geotechnical engineering services statewide. CDOT Property Management contracts, throughout the state, for construction of maintenance buildings, office buildings, support structures/buildings for rest areas, water treatment plants, secondary containment structures and installation of stormwater treatment structures, etc. CDOT is requiring statewide coverage and intends to do so by selecting up to three firms, if necessary, to ensure full coverage without delays or conflict in scheduling due to geographical project locations. Companies bidding this contract are welcome to partner to assist with this requirement. The work under this contract consists of providing geotechnical services, as described herein, on a statewide basis as assigned by individual task orders issued to access the master contract issued under this statement of interest (SOI). The purpose of the work is to provide geotechnical services including soil investigations, data interpretation and recommendations for subsequent construction projects on an “as needed” basis.

The work to be included in these contracts shall require, but not be limited to, geotechnical soil borings, conducting both field tests and laboratory tests including but not limited to lithologic descriptions of the soil, penetration tests, swell consolidation tests, gradation analysis Atterberg limits tests, and water soluble sulfates. Additionally, results and recommendations reports shall be prepared by a licensed Engineer and submitted to CDOT for each project prior to going out to bid for each construction project.

RESPONSIBILITY: The contractor shall be solely responsible for the safe and satisfactory performance of all services required by the contract resulting from this SOI. All personnel working at the site will be required to have the training appropriate to the task and shall conduct all site work in accordance with all applicable regulations including OSHA. All work under this contract is time critical and **MUST** be executed expeditiously. Individual project schedule needs will be outlined within each Task Order.
