The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency classifies the air quality status of areas within the United States as being one of the three following:

**Nonattainment** - Areas where monitored concentrations of one or more criteria pollutants violate EPA established National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). Criteria pollutants are carbon monoxide, ozone, particulate matter, nitrogen dioxide, sulfur dioxide, and lead.
