





Executive Order 11990

In 1977, President Jimmy Carter issued an Executive Order directing all federal agencies to minimize the destruction, loss or degradation of wetlands, and to preserve and enhance the natural and beneficial values of wetlands when the agencies: Acquire, manage, and dispose of federal lands and facilities; Provide federally undertaken, financed, or assisted construction or improvements; and Conduct federal activities and programs affecting land use.
