



US 6 Bridges Design Build

Busy week of construction at Federal Boulevard, Nov. 7 - 14

What

Substantial work at the Federal Boulevard bridge over US 6 to move traffic east onto newly built bridges.

When

Work will begin at about 7 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 7, with traffic in its new alignment by 5 a.m. Monday, Nov. 10. Impacts will last throughout the week in anticipation of demolishing the west half of the existing Federal bridge over US 6.

Why

Crews need to shift traffic to the east before taking down the west half of the Federal bridge over US 6. Once the old bridge is down, crews will begin building the new west half of the Federal bridge.


Details

- Federal Boulevard will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction all weekend (7 p.m. Friday, Nov. 7 through 5 a.m. Monday, Nov. 10).
- **The westbound US 6 off-ramp to Federal will close at about 10 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 7, and reopen the evening of Friday, Nov. 14, at which point it will be in its final alignment.**
- To accommodate local neighborhood traffic, the westbound US 6 off-ramp to Lowell/Perry will re-open to accommodate local neighborhood traffic. **This is one month earlier than anticipated. The ramp will remain open for the remainder of the project.**
- The Federal on-ramp to westbound US 6 and the eastbound US 6 off-ramp to Federal will close Saturday, Nov 8 at about 9 p.m. and remain closed until 5 a.m. Monday, Nov. 10.
- Other activities on Federal and the US 6 ramps include:
 - Asphalt removal and paving
 - Embankment placement at the Federal on- and off-ramps
 - Resetting of temporary barrier
 - Reconfiguring the Federal and 5th Avenue intersection and the westbound on- and off-ramp intersection
 - Installing a new waterline on the Federal bridge over US 6
- By 5 a.m. Monday, there will again be two lanes of traffic in each direction on Federal.
- There will also be new access limitations to businesses on the west side of Federal between US 6 and 4th Avenue. These will be in place for about six months while the west side of the bridge is rebuilt. Access signage will be posted to direct motorists.
- This work precedes a 31-hour closure of US 6 at Federal Boulevard for bridge demolition work. This work is currently scheduled for the weekend of Nov. 15 through Nov. 17.
- This work marks the unofficial “halftime” of the US 6 Bridges Design Build Project.

Traffic impacts

- **Federal Boulevard:** One lane of travel will be open in each direction on Federal all weekend. No detour routes will be posted, but alternate routes are advised around the area.
- **During westbound US 6 off-ramp closure:** Motorists will continue to Sheridan Boulevard, go north on Sheridan to Colfax Avenue, then go east on Colfax to access Federal. Local residents can access the surrounding neighborhoods by using the westbound US 6 off-ramp to Lowell/Perry.
- **During westbound US 6 on-ramp closure:** Motorists should take Alameda Avenue or Colfax Avenue west to Sheridan, then use Sheridan to access westbound US 6.
- **During the eastbound US 6 off-ramp closure:** Motorists should exit eastbound US 6 at Sheridan, take Sheridan south to Alameda, and then take Alameda east to access Federal.
