




I-25/Cimarron Interchange



Cimarron Interchange Taking Shape Public Open House

A crucial I-25 interchange is about to undergo major reconstruction and realignment. When complete, it will be a high-functioning interchange that safely handles more vehicles and enhances multi-modal travel for those using I-25, U.S. 24/Cimarron St. and the trail system along the creeks. A Design-Build procurement process is underway for the interchange, with construction scheduled to start in 2015. The community is invited to view the new configuration and provide feedback on various aspects of the project.
