Enclosed are the Inquiries and Responses that were received for the I-25/Cimarron Street (US 24) Interchange Design-Build Project on or before 4pm MST on March 21, 2014.

**Inquiry #1** – Regarding the Design Build Project Manager position, the CO PE licensure requirement for this role is highly unusual and may limit the ability for teams to offer up highly qualified candidates that have demonstrated expertise on DB projects. We do however understand that CDOT is interested in having a PE on the project throughout the life of the project. Is there any other way to revise the RFQ to allow the DB teams to provide their approach to accommodating the PE requirement throughout the duration of the project?

**Response #1** – Section 3.3.3 – Minimum Requirements of Key Personnel has been revised in Addenda #1 dated March 27, 2014.

**Inquiry #2** – In Section 3.2.1 Submitter Experience – do all submitted projects need to be completed projects or will you allow some projects that are substantially complete to be included among the eight?

**Response #2** – Projects reported that are not complete or substantially complete (less than 100%) must adequately reflect the requested project experience.
