



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

I-25 WIDENING (LINCOLN AVENUE TO COUNTY LINE ROAD)

TRAFFIC SHIFT PUTS ALL NORTHBOUND I-25 LANES ON NEW CONCRETE PAVEMENT

Phase 4 of the I-25 Widening Project (project) between Lincoln Avenue and County Line Road is set to begin in mid-July with another northbound I-25 traffic shift. This next phase will shift all northbound I-25 traffic onto the new concrete pavement to make room for a temporary work zone between northbound and southbound I-25. This configuration will be in place for several months.

Crews will work overnight on Thursday, July 16 to move barrier wall and prepare northbound I-25 for the new configuration on Friday, June 17, weather permitting. The traffic shift will start at RidgeGate Parkway and continue through the County Line Road off-ramp.

Motorists are encouraged to use extra attention when approaching the work zone from the south. The right lane of I-25 will be striped as an exit only lane at RidgeGate Parkway (exit 192). After this lane drop, three northbound I-25 lanes with auxiliary lanes will continue through the work zone.

All northbound lanes will be together under this configuration unlike the Phase 3 traffic split, which split northbound traffic into two left lanes and two right lanes around a temporary work zone.



UPCOMING PHASE 4 WORK & ANTICIPATED TRAVEL IMPACTS

Phase 4 reconstructs the center of I-25 between northbound and southbound directions. Most of the work occurs outside of travel lanes. However, some limited Phase 4 work will result in temporary traffic impacts. Work will occur day and night, with northbound I-25 lane closures between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Every effort will be made to minimize travel impacts and delays. I-25 WIDENING ACCOMPLISHMENTS TO DATE

Since the project began nine months ago, crews have completed the following:

- Constructed three northbound I-25 lanes, auxiliary lanes and the outside shoulder.
- Widened both Lincoln Avenue ramps, the C-470/E-470 off-ramp and the County Line off-ramp to two lanes.
- Built a new 10-foot multi-use trail along the east side of I-25 between Lincoln Avenue and the RTD Meridian Call-n-Ride / Kiss-n-Ride stop.
- Improved the RTD Meridian Call-n-Ride / Kiss-n-Ride stop on the east side of San Luis Street with bicycle lockers and other amenities.
- Installed extensive drainage infrastructure including placement of 6,050 feet of drainage pipe and construction of two water quality ponds.

I-25 WIDENING PROJECT OVERVIEW - *Improving traffic flow*

Interstate Highway Construction (IHC) was selected as the contractor for this high priority CDOT project. This project will add an additional lane in each direction on I-25 from Lincoln Avenue to County Line Road, resulting in four lanes in each direction south of the 470 interchange. This \$32 million project will be substantially complete by the end of 2015.
