I-70 & Kipling Interchange

PUBLIC MEETING



A detailed transportation study of the I-70/Kipling Street interchange is underway. The Colorado Department of Transportation is leading a team to examine alternatives for this important interchange. The I-70/Kipling PEL Study will provide an understanding of the existing conditions, while considering future surrounding development and community plans. The goal of the study is to develop a range of improvements to reduce congestion and improve operations and safety of the interchange area along I-70 and Kipling Street (SH 391). The study will provide a plan for future short- and long-term improvements.

The first phase of this 14-month study will include gathering public input and existing and future conditions analysis. The work will be closely coordinated with local agencies, communities, area businesses and commuters to identify improvements that best meet the study goals and objectives. The project team will be available to listen to your comments and answer your questions at the April 25th public meeting.
