


HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION ANNOUNCEMENT

SH 14 Paving, I-25 to WCR23



Overview

On July 6, 2015, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) will begin a resurfacing project along approximately 8 miles of State Highway (SH) 14 between Interstate 25 and County Road (CR) 23 east of Fort Collins.

This project is an important part of the long-term maintenance of the road. Work will consist of milling the old asphalt and repaving the surface with concrete to replace deteriorating pavement and provide motorists with a smoother driving surface.

Interstate Highway Construction (IHC) of Englewood, Colorado, is the contractor for this \$12.23 million project, which is slated for completion in November 2015.

Working Hours & Impacts

Normal working hours will be Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Motorists can expect one alternating lane of traffic for up to 2 miles at a time. This traffic configuration will be managed by traffic signals and motorists can expect stops of up to 15 minutes. There is a 10-foot width restriction and a 75-foot length restriction in place for oversized vehicles. Trucks exceeding these restrictions are advised to utilize US 34 as a detour.

Throughout the project, there will be limited access to north and south county roads intersecting with SH 14 between I-25 and CR 23, with detours in place.

The speed limit will be reduced to 45 mph for both the safety of the traveling public as well as construction crews working along the highway. Fines may be doubled for speed violations through the construction zone.
