

Construction Impacts for Week of Oct. 9

Lane Restrictions on Westbound Manitou Avenue

- Motorists will experience westbound traffic on Manitou Avenue switched to an eastbound lane between Garden of the Gods Place and the Manitou Pool and Fitness Center entrance (202 Manitou Avenue) for drainage work.
 - Roughly 300 feet of two-way traffic on eastbound Manitou Avenue in front of the Sinclair Gas Station.
 - Monday, Oct. 10 through Friday, Oct. 14 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Temporary No Parking Zones on Manitou Avenue

- Motorists will experience temporary no parking zones on Manitou Avenue between Old Mans Trail and El Monte Place for pedestrian ramp work.
 - Monday, Oct. 10 through Friday, Oct. 14 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Ongoing Closures

Site A Closure

Manitou Avenue between Serpentine Drive to US 24 Access Ramp at the Rainbow Falls Bridge area will remain closed. This closure will continue through Oct. 14, 2016. When permanently reopened, this portion will have a new pavement, new guardrail, and new striping. Drivers wanting to access Manitou Springs from US 24 will need to use Serpentine Drive, Washington Avenue, or preferably, the Manitou Avenue interchange. [CLICK HERE](#) for detour information.

Site B Closure

Motorists will experience a full closure at Garden of Gods Place between El Paso Boulevard and Manitou Avenue from late Sept. through late Oct. This closure allows for bridge, barrier and drainage work to happen concurrently, reducing the duration of disturbance on the road and bike path. [CLICK HERE](#) for detour information.

Project Information

The \$2.4 million CO 24 East Manitou Avenue Road Improvements project -- consists of an overlay through Manitou Springs along with Americans with Disabilities (ADA) ramp work. The project entails milling, paving, ADA ramps (approximately 30), drainage inlet and pipes, adjustments to manholes and water valves, bridge deck repairs and pavement striping. Completion is planned for late 2016.
