CDOT

- U.S. 24 Improvements
- Fountain Creek
 - (2) on U.S. 24
 - 8th Street
 - 21st Street
 - 26th Street
 - 31st Street
 - Ridge Road
- Channel improvements at each bridge to pass 100 year flood
- Water quality improvements for roadway
- Consulting fees for Greenway Master Planning Effort
- R.O.W. purchase for Roadway improvements
- Advocacy
- Participate in ongoing operations & partnerships
- Mitigation dollars that could go towards elements of the greenway

Gold Hill Mesa

- EPA Brownsfields Loan at 2%
 - separate from GHM – GHM repay improvements within property, to address streambank stabilization, flooding, erosion
 - \$ 2 million pool to an entity
 - limited window of opportunity conduit for funding vehicle
- Money also available for other Brownfields sites

Stormwater Enterprise – COS

- Bridge over Fountain Creek at 8th Street
- Fountain Creek Bridge at 21st Street
- OK to swap bridge/channel with CDOT
- Partner with CDOT on water quality features
 - capital cost – technology
- Likely to maintain water quality features

Manitou Springs

- Extend Creekwalk Trail east from Schryver Park to Fields Park in 2007

- Extend Creekwalk Trail east from Fields Park to city limits 2008
- Maintain trail segment in city limits
- Participate in ongoing operations

Friends of Red Rock Canyon

- Volunteer Labor
 - Trail Building
 - Maintenance
 - "Ambassadors"
- Fund raising for some re-vegetation
- Grant applicant

TOPS – Parks and Recreation

- Funding for trail surface (12 ft. concrete) from 21st Street to Manitou Springs (Question about transfer of ownership)
- Maintain trail within city limits
- Own/Maintain "pearls" on string
- Forestry maintains trees in TOPS facilities – Provide tech expertise for urban forest (Gary Rapp's group – Shooks Run)
- Grant applicant
- Volunteer Coordination
- Adopt-a-Trail
- Community relations, communication
- "Re-purposing" existing parks to link to greenway

TOSC

- Foundation start-up (not the foundation)
- Foundation on-going consulting
- Active Advocacy
- Limit direct funding
- Fund identification
- Conduit for grants
- Grant-writing
- Coordinate/Mobilize volunteer labor

OWN

- Publicity, communications
- Grant recipient
- Limited Volunteer labor mobilization
