(DRAFT) Update: U.S. 40 Reconstruction Project for May 5-9, 2010

Phase 1, 2 & 3 Work Zone

Starts Monday, 5/10 weather permitting.

- Lefts from Lincoln Ave. towards Yampa at 5th, 7th and 12th only.
- Lefts from Lincoln Ave. towards Oak at 12th and 3rd only.
- Work Zone Crosswalks and Bus Stops at 5th, and near 7th, 9th & 13th - watch for tall purple flags.
- No parking along Lincoln Ave. plenty on side streets & nearby parking lots.
- Overnight paving 9th-7th streets as soon as Tues-Wed

Update: Phase 2 paving starts as soon as Mon., May 10 Phase 3 demolition starts Friday if 12th & 13th are reopened (depends on weather)

- **Overnight paving** began Tuesday on Phase 2 (11th-9th streets) on U.S. 40, closing the north side of Lincoln Ave. as shown on the map above. Paving the 2nd half of Phase 3 (9th-7th) will start as soon as Monday 5/10 7 p.m.-Tues. 5/11 weather permitting. During these hours traffic will be detoured between 12th and 7th onto Yampa.
- **Left turns off Lincoln Ave. toward Yampa Street** at 5th, 7th and 12th streets only
- **12th and 3rd streets are the only Lincoln Ave. lefts toward Oak** (these intersections would remain open in all directions and have flaggers at peak traffic times).
- **Work Zone crosswalks** and bus stops are at 5th, near 7th, & at 13th streets-watch for tall purple flags
- No parking along Lincoln Ave. from 3rd-13th streets-**plenty of parking** on side streets and in nearby lots.

Travel Tips:

- 1) Traffic will flow in one lane in each direction on U.S. 40/Lincoln Ave. through the work zone (with some limited overnight Lincoln Ave. closures during paving beginning 4/13.)
- 2) Motorists are being encouraged to make their left turns outside of downtown in an effort to increase traffic flows through Old Town.

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- 3) To reduce the number of vehicle trips through town, parents are being encouraged to have their children take school buses or to carpool.
- 4) Old Town workers are being encouraged to park in outlying lots and walk or take free shuttle buses to work, in order to free up downtown parking for customers.
- 5) City buses will continue to operate along Lincoln Ave. during construction.
- 6) Cyclists should continue to use bike lanes provided along Oak and Yampa streets and plan to cross the Lincoln Ave. work zone at designated pedestrian crossings (well marked)
- 7) CDOT has a wide load restriction (over 10 feet) on U.S. 40 throughout the project.

- 8) **Ongoing 13th Street Impacts:** From 7 a.m. -7 p.m. currently left turns will not be allowed from Lincoln onto 13th while work is underway on the north side of the intersection. To access the Fairview neighborhood and 20-mile Business Area motorists will be required to detour to the James Brown Soul Center of the Universe Bridge. Trucks and large vehicles will not be able to access U.S. 40 from 13th St. Library Patrons are encouraged to use alternate parking areas at Little Toots Park and to the west of West Lincoln Park.
